02/000058	MANSON Bible (1)	Embossed and gilded leather bible with initial entry James Manson born 1832 and Mary born 1837 married 1857 Scotch Church Sydney. Transcription of details and research done by SAG volunteer is included; also photograph of their headstone.	
02/000103	DUGUID Bible (33)	Duguid family bible, covers missing, in poor condition, some repairs, some later pages missing; two pages of genealogical information containing entries of descendants of William Duguid & Elizabeth Cheyne married 1755. The bible was in the possession of Miss Margaret Windeyer.	
02/000124	HAINES Bible (18)	Bible of the Haines and Mann family 1678	
02/000271	UNDERWOOD Bible (8)	Underwood family bible, printed 1835, given to Susanna Underwood by her brother James Day 8 Apr 1838; contains entries for the Day family of Rose Cottage, Pyrmont (1795-1839) and Underwood family (1841-1873); birth entries for the children of William & Susanna Underwood 1842 - 1857. Photocopies of genealogical information are held at 4/5102, and there are digital images available.	
02/000296	CARGEEG Bible (39)	Large bible in good condition. Original family John & Catherine Cargeeg, both born 1834, married in Morvah, Cornwall, England. 8 children 1861 to 1877. Marriage of son Alfred to Edith Gibson 1898 is recorded. 7 deaths recorded.

04/009980	ELLIS Bible (16)	Embossed leather cover with Jane Ellis 1846 in gold. Front cover inscription is "With Hardys best wishes". Pages from Jane Ellis New Testament with family births etc entered 1800-1912; photocopies of other pages still in Bible. Recent research, indicates Jane Ellis may be the daughter of Charles Ellis and Hannah Ellis nee Schofield of Huddersfield Yorkshire ENG.	
04/027304	TAYLOR Bible (35)	Inscription to Miss Taylor from the teachers at the South Fremantle Methodist Sunday School. There is a partial date apparently in 1911. The other Register pages are for a Hersey family in early C20 with a final link of marriage of Evelyn Margaret Hersey to Lindsay Ford 1946. Mr and Mrs L A Ford and family of South Australia donated this bible to SAG in 1970.	
04/027305	HART-BARTLETT Bible (34)	Bible with soft leather cover, good condition, with inscription to Emma Bartlett nee Hart (1837-1929) wife of Arthur Charles Bartlett. Register entries show details of births, marriages and deaths of their children. Additional material on later generations is on separate sheets of paper; plus there are newscuttings of deaths which offer further data on family members. There is also a photograph. Donor specifically expressed her desire (she is from Georgiana's line) that the bible be offered to other family members if they were found.

04/027308	BARR Bible (4)	<p>BARR Bible; Family originally came from Scotland after their marriage in Glasgow on 3 October 1870 arriving on the "Alexandrina" in Brisbane 7 February 1875. Documentation of the research undertaken by a SAG member includes copies of 1871 English Census; shipping list; photograph of the ship "Alexandrina" and newspaper clippings relating to the family.</p> <p>Last traces of the family are of a search in 1962 for heirs of John Cameron Barr of Springwood,NSW, son of Robert & Margaret Barr. Early photocopies from the bible are in 4/8667.</p>	
04/027309	SMITH Bible (5)	<p>The family bible of Robert Augustus Smith and Mary Jane Booth who married 1899 in Nowra,NSW. Both were teachers, and the research work done by a SAG volunteer, which is included, includes printouts of their postings. Pages with genealogical material have been digitised.</p>	
04/027310	RAMSAY Bible (9)	<p>Embossed leather cover with British and Foreign Bible Society lozenge. First page has a bookplate - Wilson Ramsay T.C.D., "Ora et Labora". There are 2 pages of genealogical material of Ramsay and Birney family members - latest entry is 1873.</p> <p>Research done by a SAG volunteer and SAG Archives Officer includes a likely family tree showing William Ramsay(1817-1855) marrying Sarah Jane Birney (1815-1873) in Dublin 1845. Living Ramsay relatives who were SAG Members were contacted in 2015 but were not interested in acquiring the bible.</p>

04/027311	WARE Bible (10)	Embossed leather cover; initial inscription is William and Harriet Ware 1852. William married Harriet Pound in 1852; their issue, 5 boys and 3 girls 1854 thru 1868, are listed on a single page. Of interest is a small newscutting attached to the first page recording the marriage of James Gibbison of Mile-End to Jane Gibbison of Adelaide - no year. Research done by a SAG Member is included.	
04/027312	WATSON Bible (12)	This bible is in a fragile condition and has not been re-opened for further cataloguing. It is wrapped in brown paper, tied with string, and has a white label with the inscription Bible of Watson family of Norwich Norfolk England 1725.	
04/027313	YOUNG Bible (14)	The front cover of the bible has the British & Foreign Bible Society V lozenge. Inscription of flyleaf reads John Young Junr. given to him by his Father November 2nd 1829. A further inscription on the following page records that John gave the book to his brother Samuel on March 31st 1845, They/he were heading to Hobart Town.	
04/027314	WHITE Bible (21)	Inscription on fly leaf reads To E A White a birthday gift from her loving husband John W White Sydney 7th August 1873. On the following page there is a newscutting recording the death of David White at his grandfather's house aged 6 years. There are further inscriptions in pencil on both pages, in a childish hand. Research done by a SAG Member is included.

04/027315	SILVESTER Bible (23)	Stamped on the centre of front cover, British and Foreign Bible Society, and Sold under cost ten pence. Inscription inside front cover E J Silvester 28 T...ale Street Newtown 24 April. Ellena Elizabeth Silvester c/o Mrs Lane No 3 James St - line missing due to water damage - Sydney. A separate scrap of paper says "Probably Navy Issue". See 4/11413 and 4/10898 (Gibson Papers).	
04/027317	WHITE - HULLEY Bible (28)	Blue cloth cover with text in gold - Bible Readings for the Home Circle; dedication is to Elisabeth Emily White from her mother, 1891. There are several pages recording births, marriages and deaths of the Hulley and Abrahams families in country Victoria and NSW. On the final page there is the Slater family in Sydney suburbs (5 children born between 1947 and 1961) with the most recent entries being of Anthony, wife Maria and daughter Larissa in 1970s.	
04/027318	COLLIER Bible (32)	Old brown leather bible - scruffy but intact. Inscription is James Collier. Under this and in a different hand appears to be Geo. S Collier born 25 July 1808. On inside cover there are notes in pencil 'Bible of 1764' etc; also in ink in another hand H / Rumsey.	
04/027319	HUTCHINGS Bible (13)	Bible with soft leather cover, inscription on inside front cover is W Hutchings. Contains 2 pages of newscuttings. See also 4/8596 which includes photocopies of the bible pages.

04/027359	BRICKHAM Bible (38)	Old and fairly battered, embossed leather bible. Inscription is John Brickham's Book 1764. Under this in very faint ink is 'God gave His Grace theron to thee'. On further page 'Relations to home we ought Esteem Died' followed by deaths of Topcroft family members from 1836 thru 1869. On another page is inscription John Brickham's Book November 15 1768.	
04/028227	BYRNES Bible (2)	Very large bible with cloth cover over original. Inscription is to William Byrnes from Mrs Oakes. Register pages have not been completed. This William Oakes is probably the one who married Anne Oakes in 1834.
